Day to Day itinerary

23 Jan Tue - DAY 1

Upon your arrival, check in to our hotel in Jerusalem, where you will be staying for the next few nights. Take some time to freshen up before our introductory meeting with your guide for the week.

Later in the evening, enjoy a delicious dinner at our hotel. During the meal, we will have an orientation talk to provide you with an overview of our exciting program for the upcoming week. Get ready for a memorable journey filled with exploration, learning, and meaningful experiences.

24 Jan Wed - DAY 2

Begin the day with a visit to the Mount of Olives, a site of great significance in Christian tradition. Enjoy panoramic views of Jerusalem and visit the Chapel of the Ascension.

Proceed to the Garden of Gethsemane, where Jesus prayed before his crucifixion. Spend some quiet moments of reflection and prayer amidst ancient olive trees.

Continue to Explore the City of David, an archaeological site that provides insight into the biblical history of Jerusalem. Discover ancient ruins and learn about King David's reign.

After lunch, we will Visit the Davidson Center, an archaeological park near the Western Wall. Explore the Southern Wall excavations, giving a glimpse into the Second Temple period.

Experience the spiritual atmosphere at the Western Wall, one of the holiest sites in Judaism.

Witness prayers and rituals performed by devout Jews. Participants may offer their prayers here as well. Finish the day with a Visit to the Garden Tomb, a serene and contemplative site believed by some to be the burial and resurrection place of Jesus. Engage in a meaningful worship service in the peaceful garden surroundings.

Tonight we will have a meeting with an Israeli official to give a background about the Israel geo-political status.

25 Jan Thu - DAY 3

Today, we will travel south to meet local farmers and assist them with their work. Since October 7, all foreign employees who used to work in the fields left Israel, disrupting the vegetable and fruit supply chain. In response, Israeli citizens have stepped up to volunteer and salvage some of the goods.

The farmers still need substantial assistance, and our support is invaluable. Throughout the day, we will visit the locations where the events of October 7 unfolded. Additionally, there will be a military overview of the region and its historical context, providing participants with a deeper understanding of the area's significance and challenges.

26 Jan Fri - DAY 4

We will start our day with a speaker from the foreign ministry of Israel.

Continue to a visit to Yad Vashem, the World Holocaust Remembrance Center. Explore the museum, exhibitions, and the Hall of Names, honoring the memory of the six million Jews who perished during the Holocaust. Participate in a guided tour to gain a deep understanding of this tragic period in history and its unimaginable connection to today. Continue to Mount Herzl, Israel's national cemetery and a site of great historical and cultural significance.

We will continue to have lunch in Machne Yehuda market Jerusalem's famous open-air market. Experience the colors, aromas, and flavors of the Middle East as you stroll through the market's bustling alleys. Engage with local vendors, sample fresh produce, and taste a variety of local delicacies.

After lunch, we will drive to the location for Kabbalat Shabbat (Welcoming the Shabbat). This period will be dedicated to prayer and reflection in this sacred space.

Later, we will gather for a Shabbat dinner, delving deeper into the Jewish tradition.

27 Jan Sat - DAY 5

Begin the day with a visit to the Israel Museum, one of the world's leading art and archaeology museums. Explore a vast collection of artifacts, including the Dead Sea Scrolls, ancient artworks, and historical exhibits that provide deep insights into the region's rich heritage. Continue to Mount Zion, a site of great religious significance. Visit the Room of the Last Supper, traditionally believed to be the location of Jesus' last meal with his disciples. Explore the Tomb of King David and experience the spiritual ambiance of the surround.

After lunch, we will continue to the enchanting Jewish Quarter of the Old City, known for its narrow winding streets, historical synagogues, and vibrant cultural atmosphere.

Engage in a thought-provoking geo-political overview led by an ex-military commentator. Gain valuable insights into the complex political landscape of the region, understanding the historical context and current challenges faced by Israel.

This session aims to provide a comprehensive perspective on the geopolitical factors shaping the nation's dynamics.

Conclude the day with group discussions, reflecting on the day's experiences.

28 Jan Sun - DAY 6

We check out our hotel from Jerusalem and start our day traveling to Tel Aviv visiting the Anu Museum, a unique institution dedicated to showcasing Israeli art and culture. Explore diverse exhibits featuring contemporary artworks, historical artifacts, and interactive displays that provide insights into the country's vibrant artistic heritage.

We will visit the logistic center established by "Ahaim Laneshek" (Brothers In Arm) to support victim families

and individuals who had to leave everything behind to start a new life. This initiative stands as the largest civilian effort in Israel today, providing essential aid and assistance to those in need. After lunch, we will travel north,

Travel to Megiddo, an ancient archaeological site often associated with the biblical Armageddon. Explore the well-preserved ruins of this historical city, gaining a glimpse into its significance in ancient civilizations. Visit the archaeological excavations, and ancient gates, and learn about Megiddo's rich history through expert-guided tours.

Continue your journey to Magdala, a town with historical and biblical importance. Visit the Magdala Center, which houses ancient synagogues and archaeological discoveries dating back to the time of Jesus. Explore the ruins, including the Magdala Stone, and learn about the town's connection to biblical narratives.

We will have a meeting with an organization called "Hashomer Hahadsh" who took responsibility for safeguarding Israel's lands by engaging in agricultural and forestry work alongside educational initiatives that strengthen connections to the land.

29 Jan Mon - DAY 7

Embark on a scenic Boat Ride on the Sea of Galilee, where biblical stories come to life. Experience the tranquility of the water as you sail, absorbing the picturesque views of the surrounding hills and landscapes. Engage in moments of reflection and prayer, connecting with the spiritual significance of the sea.

Visit the Mount of Beatitudes, the serene hill where Jesus is believed to have delivered the Sermon on the Mount. Explore the beautiful gardens and enjoy panoramic views of the Sea of Galilee. Take time for personal reflection and meditation in this peaceful setting.

Embark on a Jeep Ride along the Northern border of Israel, exploring rugged terrains and picturesque landscapes. Traverse off-road paths, encountering the natural beauty of the region while learning about its historical and geographical significance. Along the way, stop at strategic viewpoints, and learn about the history of the Northern border of Israel.

Tonight, we will conclude our mission with a special dinner in Yesod Hama'ala, joined by Gadi Elias. Together, we will engage in meaningful conversations and reflections, discussing our observations and lessons learned throughout the week. We will explore ways in which we can support Israel and raise awareness about the challenges faced by its people, highlighting both the tragedy and the resilience of the Israeli community to the world.
